

First Year Experience Advisory Council

[Membership: 16 people: 6 faculty (one from each college), 1 from LIB, 3 from Dean of Students Office, 1 from Institutional Diversity, 1 from Residence Life, 2 student representatives, FYE Coordinator, FYE Assistant Coordinator] The council currently meets the last Friday of each month (September, October, November, January, February, March and April) from 1:30-3:00 pm.

Charge:

The First-Year Experience (FYE) Advisory Council provides recommendations and guidance to the Vice-Provost for Academic Affairs and the FYE Coordinator. Specifically, this council: recommends candidates for the position of FYE Coordinator; offers advice on programmatic and institutional initiatives related to FYE 101 and 301; assists the FYE Coordinator with curricular changes and assessment practices; reviews and makes recommendations for instructor/faculty appointments; offers feedback and advice on annual reports, workshops, conferences, and reviews; serves as liaisons to academic and student service offices sharing information, resources and opportunities related to the first college year; recommends initiatives or collaborations to raise academic performance and advance teaching and learning, and; advises the Vice-Provost and FYE Coordinator on strategies to continually enhance programmatic efforts.
