All are voting members. All faculty must be members of the graduate faculty. *Those departments generating the most SCH. (Approved by Senate 9/22/09) [Meets 3rd Monday, 3:30 – 5:00 pm]

Charge: Serve as a faculty advisory and policy-recommending body for the interdisciplinary MSA. Should be concerned with the development of curriculum and the evaluation of programs and policies pertaining to the MSA program both on- and off-campus. Primary responsibility for quality of program offerings, faculty selection related to core courses, and student requirements.
