

ACADEMIC PROBATION POLICY

At the end of each semester or summer session, a student whose cumulative grade point average falls within the range for the interval of credit hours shown in the following table is placed on academic probation. The range is determined by attempted hours or total hours, whichever is greater. Total hours include credits earned at CMU as well as transfer credits or hours earned in any other manner.

Attempted/Total Hours	GPA Ranges
1-18	1.00-1.99
19-35	1.50-1.99
36-45	1.70-1.99
46-58	1.80-1.99
59-71	1.85-1.99
72-85	1.90-1.99
86 and over	1.95-1.99

The university notifies students who are placed on academic probation, and encourages them to seek counseling and assistance. If a student is on academic probation for three consecutive semesters the student may be academically dismissed from the university.
