

GUIDELINES CONCERNING WEARING OF HONOR SOCIETY INSIGNIA AT COMMENCEMENT

DASH will consider requests for approval for members of an honor society to wear appropriate insignia during Commencement on a case-by-case basis. Once approval by DASH is granted, no further action is required.

DASH will review applications of honor societies that meet the following requirements:

- The honor society is recognized as a Registered Student Organization (RSO) at Central Michigan University. The RSO status must be active at the time of commencement; AND
- The honor society is a member of the Association for College Honor Societies (ACHS); OR
- In the event that the honor society is not a member of the ACHS, it must meet the following criteria:
 - The honor society is a nationally recognized organization with a national constitution and guidelines for membership. The constitution and bylaws of the local chapter must adhere to the national standards.
 - The minimum grade point average for admission to the honor society is 3.25 (on a 4.0 scale).

Appeals to DASH decisions will go to the Academic Senate.

Applications should be submitted to DASH at least one semester prior to desired activation date.

DASH shall maintain a list of all societies and insignias approved for graduation attire.
